Job Description

The purpose of this role is to guide our guests down our rivers safely, enthusiastically, and professionally.

Requirements for Guides:

- Possess a current Wilderness First Aid and CPR certification.
- Reporting to the Operations Manager regarding scheduling.
- Reporting to the River Manager regarding river trips, boating equipment needs and repairs.
- Gaining familiarity with and utilizing Arctic to check work schedule daily.
- Being able to adapt to changes in daily logistics.
- Must be responsible and make a full commitment to the job.
- Possessing good time management.
- Being on time and prepared for all scheduled shifts.
- Safety conscious practices on and off the river.
- Janitorial, grounds, camp work and additional duties as needed.
- Working outdoors in all types of weather conditions for extended periods of time.
- The ability to maintain a professional appearance and demeanor.
- Possessing the desire and ability to interact with guests and staff in a friendly and professional manner.
- Maintaining a good attitude and keeping morale high throughout the season.
- Practicing environmentally sound processes.

Additional Requirements for Trip Leaders:

- Possess a current Swiftwater Rescue certification.
- Knowing all emergency protocols and equipment including the Somewear device and app.
- Gaining familiarity with and utilizing Arctic to check Trip Roster and Trip Report.
- Being responsible for filling out, collecting and filing all applicable paperwork.
- Possessing the ability to lead a thorough pre-rafting safety briefing.
- Leading pre/post trip debriefs as needed.
- Managing the cleanliness and general upkeep of the boat shed/deck area.
